Questions & Answers

1. Q Who do I pay my fees to?

A. All fees to be paid via cash, cheque or credit card to be paid directly to Mark Farrer (Treasurer) or Donna Kosakiewicz (President) ONLY. Mark or Donna will be available on training nights from 4.30 till the end of the last training session. Direct debit is also available, just remember to note family name on your remittance.

2. Q When are fees due?

A Fees are due before round 1 in order to receive your discount. Any fees paid after Round 1 full amount is due. If no arrangement has been made with Executive committee to pay fees in full by Round 4 then the player in question will not be eligible to play until fees are paid in full. Should you have financial difficulty paying your fees you **must** contact us **before Round 1** to arrange weekly installments until fees are paid in full. This arrangement must be adhered to.

Q Where do I purchase merchandise?

A There is a link on the devonmeadowsjfc.com website with an order form that you can pre-fill in and send back to the treasurer.dmjfc@gmail.com or you can order through the Secretary, treasurer or President. Please note a 50% deposit will be required for all placed orders. The club in the past have been left to pay for merchandise pre-ordered but never collected. For merchandise that has personal names or nicknames on them the full amount must be paid in full prior to order being placed.

4. Q What is your policy to mouthguards being worn?

A The club has a **NO Mouthguard NO Play** policy. We would appreciate that all parents make the effort to protect their kids teeth and get them into a habit of protecting their teeth and wearing a mouthguard.

5. Q What nights do we have training?

A Training nights are Wednesday and Friday nights. The junior teams commence anywhere from 4.30pm onwards. All training sessions go for an hour.
